Each CERTA Train-the-trainer Reauthorization **PROGRAM ATTENDEE** is required to complete this form and submit it to NRCA before the start of the class.

The CERTA Train-the-trainer Reauthorization program is a pass/fail course. Participants must pass a written examination, a roofing torch performance examination and the instructors' evaluations to become reauthorized CERTA instructors.

Attendees must meet the following prerequisites in order to attend this program:

1. Applicants must have passed the original 10-hour NRCA/MRCA Train-the-trainer Authorization course.
2. Applicants must have maintained their ability to use a roofing torch since their original training.
3. Applicants must have conducted a formalized training class within 12 months before the expiration of his/her authorized status. (For example, a foreman who regularly delivers "Toolbox Talks" would qualify.)
